- Summer Tax Bills are mailed out the last day of June
- Treasurer’s Office will be open Sept. 14, 2016 from 10:00am to 2:00pm to accept tax payments
- Winter Tax Bills are mailed out the last day of Nov.
- Treasurer’s Office will be open Dec. 29, 2016 from 9:00am to 5:00pm to accept tax payments
- Winter Tax Payments are due by Feb. 15, 2017
- After February 15th 1% interest will be added to the tax

payment.
•Treasurer’s Office will be open February 28, 2017 from 9:00am to 5:00pm **THIS IS THE LAST DAY TO PAY TAXES AT THE TOWNSHIP TO AVOID PENALTIES AND INTEREST.**

SEWER FEE INCREASES – January 1, 2017 the sewer rate is \$39 per month. You may pay as many months is advance as you like. 12 months = \$468, 6 months = \$234, 3 months = \$117. If you pay your bill timely or ahead of time you avoid late charges, interest and penalties.

The connection fee is \$300.

No persons, clubs, organizations, private entities, etc may use government owned lands **for any reason** without PRIOR Yates Township Board approval.



If you are going to use the lake learn the laws and rules! Let everyone enjoy the water and beaches. **That includes wildlife and humans.** PLEASE NOTE : **THERE IS A WAVE LAW IN EFFECT ON IDLEWILD LAKE! THIS PERTAINS TO JET SKIERS AS WELL AS BOATERS.**

BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:30 PM-11:00 AM, NO WAVE MAKING IS ALLOWED.

Please consider the fishing people and the wildlife when you are on the water during these. We all know very few people who use the lake are obeying this ruling. Be considerate and vigilant in abiding by the law and enforcing it when you see it being broken. No one wants to ruin their day getting a ticket and a fine.

Those rules and others are posted on the beach and boat launch. And check with the DNR..NEVER are you allowed to run down wildlife with your jet skis or boats.
